

# DEC Permitting for Physical Control Techniques-Partial Lake

- Hand harvesting-
  - Small shoreline areas-no permits usually required
  - Larger plots- DEC Article 15, Article 24?
- Benthic barriers-
  - DEC Article 15; Article 24 if barriers are not removed periodically
  - Recommended that barriers are limited to nearshore/dock and for access to open water
  - issued by county/region
- Dredging-
  - DEC Article 15, Article 24- issued by county/region
  - Sediment sampling needed unless spoils >90% gravel/sand
- Hydroraking/Rotovating-
  - DEC Article 15, Article 24- issued by county/region



# DEC Permitting for Physical Control Techniques-Whole Lake

- Drawdown-
  - DEC Article 15, Article 24
  - US Army Corps of Engineers navigable waters
- Mechanical harvesting-
  - No permits required except in wetlands (Article 24)
  - Permits not likely granted near wetlands
- Shading-
  - None or NYCRR Part 327 (pesticides)



# DEC Permitting for Biological Control Techniques

- Grass Carp-
  - DEC Article 11
  - Full Environmental Assessment Form (EAF)
  - Issued by DEC Region 7
- Herbivorous Insects
  - DEC Article 11
  - Issued by DEC Region 7



# DEC Permitting for Chemical Control Techniques

- Aquatic Pesticides-
  - NYCRR Part 327 permit
  - Supplemental EIS
  - Aquatic Plant Management/Monitoring Plan  
(Enhanced Review requirements)
  - Issued by DEC Region 7
